

OPEN DAY – TOUR GUIDE INFORMATION – 14 March 2024

- Please visit each of the areas listed below in order.
- You will meet the visiting families near the enrolments stall adjacent to the carpark
- When you arrive in each area of the tour, go into the room/space, explain to the visitors where they are and what happens in that area.
- Stay in each area for several minutes – allow the parents opportunities to look around and ask questions.
- Guests are welcome to use the Staff Only bathrooms. No access to student bathrooms.

1. Room: Library

The library is a fantastic learning space and well-equipped to meet the needs of young to very young learners. It provides a number of different learning experiences in a focussed and calm environment. Teachers can take their classes here and lunch time activities are also offered, such as Lego Club and Maths extension. And we have a bird!

2. Room: Reception classroom (Mrs Knightly's classroom)

These are typical learning spaces for our youngest – Reception and Year 1 classrooms. They are lovingly decorated and offer a variety of learning spaces within the one space. Our excellent teachers generally work with the students across most learning areas but at times students also see specialist teachers, for example for Indonesian, Music and Art, PE and Science.

3. Room: Performing Arts Centre (PAC)

This is our fantastic multi-purpose space in the Junior School. It is used PE but also dance, performances and even liturgies. It has an excellent Audio/Visual set up and a number of screens for presentations.

And it also hosts our playgroup for the littlest in our school community.

4. Room: Science Lab

Here our students can have hands-on experiences in Science and explore the natural world around them. The use of iPads is an integral part of making learning here not just interesting but also fun.

Walk back past the library, then left and on the footpath leading back to the carpark (with the Year 2 classrooms on your left).

5. Room: Back to Enrolments Stall adjacent to carpark
