2026 SCHOLARSHIPS FOR CURRENT STUDENTS

St Columba College is delighted to offer Academics Scholarships for 2026, for students currently enrolled in Years 2–11. These Scholarships aim to create an educational opportunity for a young person who would otherwise not have access to an Anglican and Catholic education.

Year 3 - 12 Academic Scholarships

- Entering Years 3–12 in 2026.
- For students who demonstrate outstanding application to their studies and high achievement and aptitude in one or more curriculum area.
- 50% tuition fee remission for Years 3–12.

Criteria for Successful Applicants

Applicants must demonstrate their abilities to benefit from a St Columba education and a willingness to contribute to the life of the College. Successful applicants will demonstrate all or some of the following:

- Ability to embrace the ethos and values of the College.
- A positive attitude to learning.
- Evidence of striving for personal excellence across all learning areas.
- Active participation in Student Life activities.
- Well-developed communication skills.
- Formal and informal student leadership.

Applicants for Academic Scholarships will be asked to provide evidence of their academic achievement and may be asked to undertake additional testing as part of the application process, or use evidence of prior testing at the College.

Terms and Conditions

The Scholarship may be terminated or suspended due to poor academic habits and outcomes, or behaviour problems. An evaluation will be made for each recipient to determine if they are still eligible to continue with the Scholarship for the following year. A total of two siblings per family shall be considered for the Scholarship Program.

Selection Process

References, current academic reports and College testing will be taken into account. Based on all of the information, a decision will be made on which students will be awarded a Scholarship.
