- The St Columba Annual Arts Competition attracted 757 entries that were submitted across Reception Year 12
- We welcomed back old scholar Dr Fiona Bright to the College to award her the Alumni Award for 2023
- Our senior Debating Team finished second in the State after the first round of debates
- The College musical, 'The Lion King Jr', was an extremely successful live production with over 100 students from Years 6-12 as cast and crew at the Shedley Theatre
- Our sporting exchange with Xavier College and our the Knights of the Southern Cross competition with Thomas More and Xavier
- Our Futures and Careers Expo provided information about prospective pathways. We were delighted to see so many students
 from Years 9-12 and their families participate in this event
- Our students sang at the Catholic Schools Music Festival at the Festival Theatre
- The student voice became stronger with action teams led by our Prefects and Junior School Leaders.
